Any cancellation of stalls prior to 31th July 2019 will incur a \$30.00 cancellation fee per stall. There is considerable paperwork and adjustments required with cancellations resulting in the necessity for this fee. There will be **NO REFUND** of payments made on stalls cancelled after this date. Stalls will be re-allocated to applicants on the waiting list after this date.

Just to let you know that we have made a few changes to next year's starting & finishing times. The Museum will be open on both days from 8am as usual for stall holders to set up, but the fair will be open to the public from 9am to 4pm Saturday and 9am to 3pm on Sunday.

Due to increased insurance and safety obligations, all aisles and areas accessible to the public must be kept clear at all times. All reasonable instructions issued by the Events Organiser or Safety Officer must be followed.
